Mary is a registered social worker and was Executive Director of Catholic Family Services of Durham for 5 years. She has been in the social work field for 40 years, working with children and families.

Mary has provided consultation and training to the Canadian Armed Forces in Europe, and to the Anglican Diocese of Toronto.

Mary was engaged by the Primate of Canada and Saint George's Anglican Cathedral in Kingston, Ontario, to intervene in the aftermath of a long-term, multi-victim abuse of boys in the cathedral choir. She has been a consultant to the Canadian Jesuits and to numerous churches, dioceses and religious orders regarding personal boundaries in ministry.
